Windrock is proud to announce the introduction of the new Model 6310/DA reciprocating machinery diesel analyzer. Similar to our 6310/MA, the 6310/DA is a two-channel data acquisition analyzer and allows for collection of dynamic cylinder pressures, vibration and ultrasonic data vs. crank-angle degree in any dual combination. The 6310/DA comes standard with high-temperature rated pressure and vibration cables and a partial armor sleeve for added durability.

Training Classes have been set for the upcoming year. We continue to add classes to broaden our course offerings, giving you a wide variety of subjects designed for every skill level.

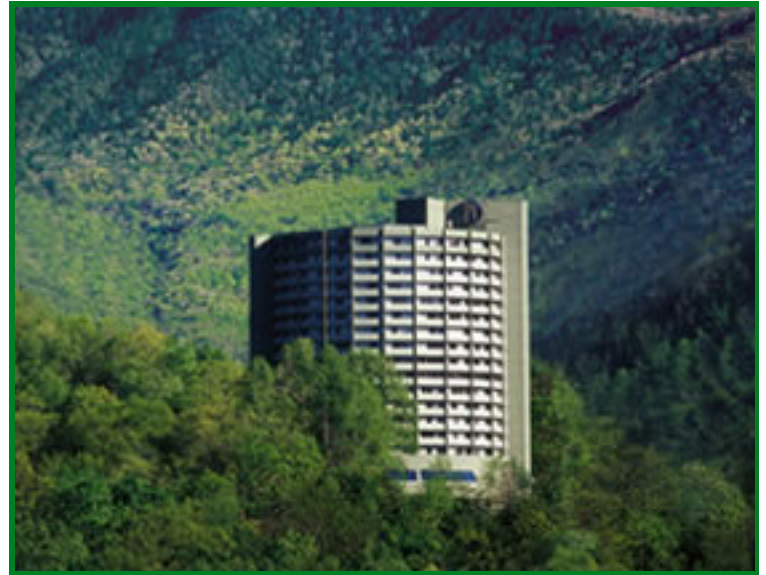
